



Foam Containers Prohibited

City of Portland Foam Ban Effective April 15, 2015

Beginning this date, the use of polystyrene foam packaging is prohibited in the City of Portland. This includes food service materials such as cups, plates, bowls, clamshell take out boxes and other items used to contain prepared food. This ordinance covers establishments including restaurants, convenience stores, food trucks, cafeterias, pubs, caterers, coffee shops, grocery stores and other businesses preparing or packaging food for retail sale.
